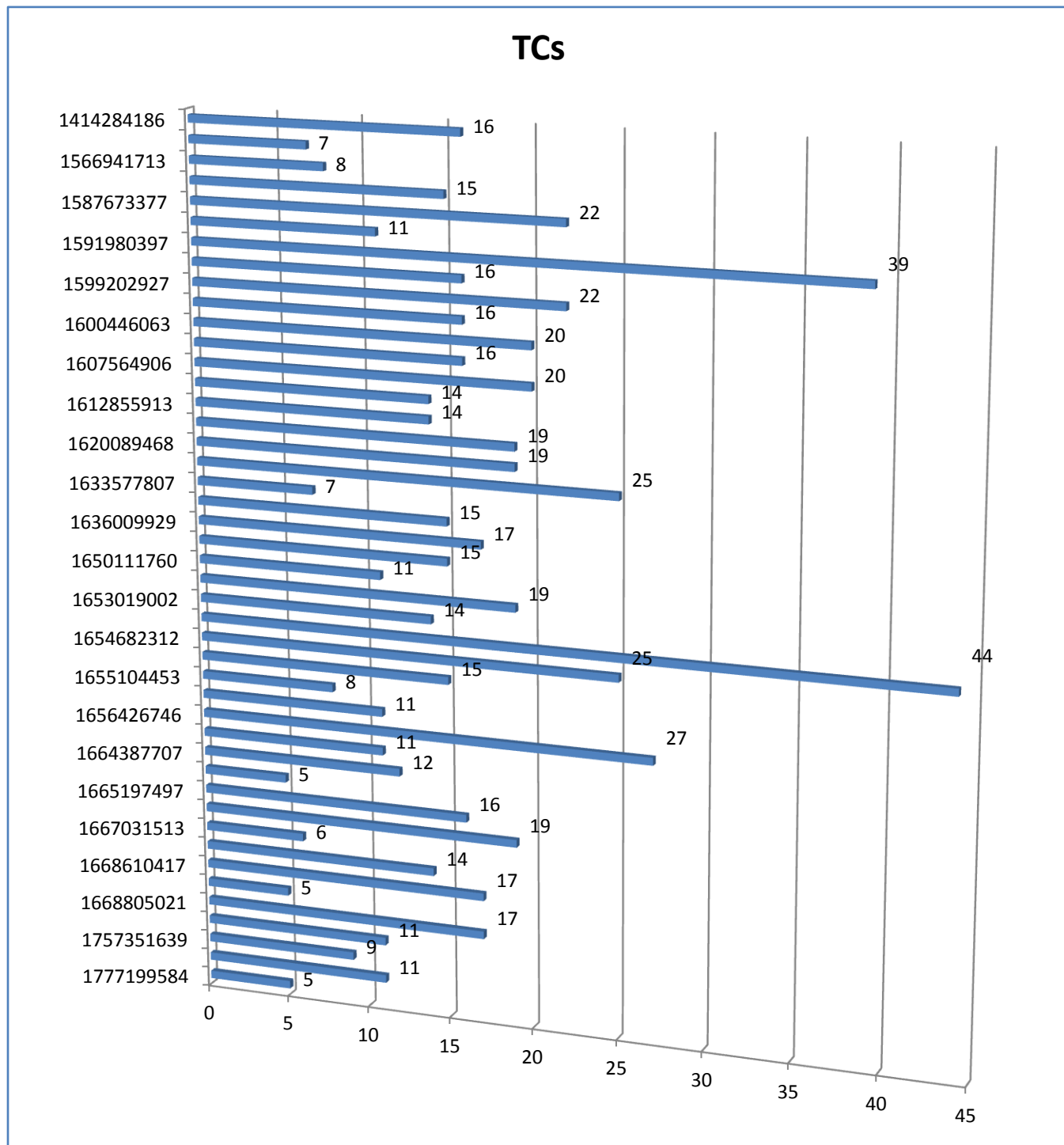


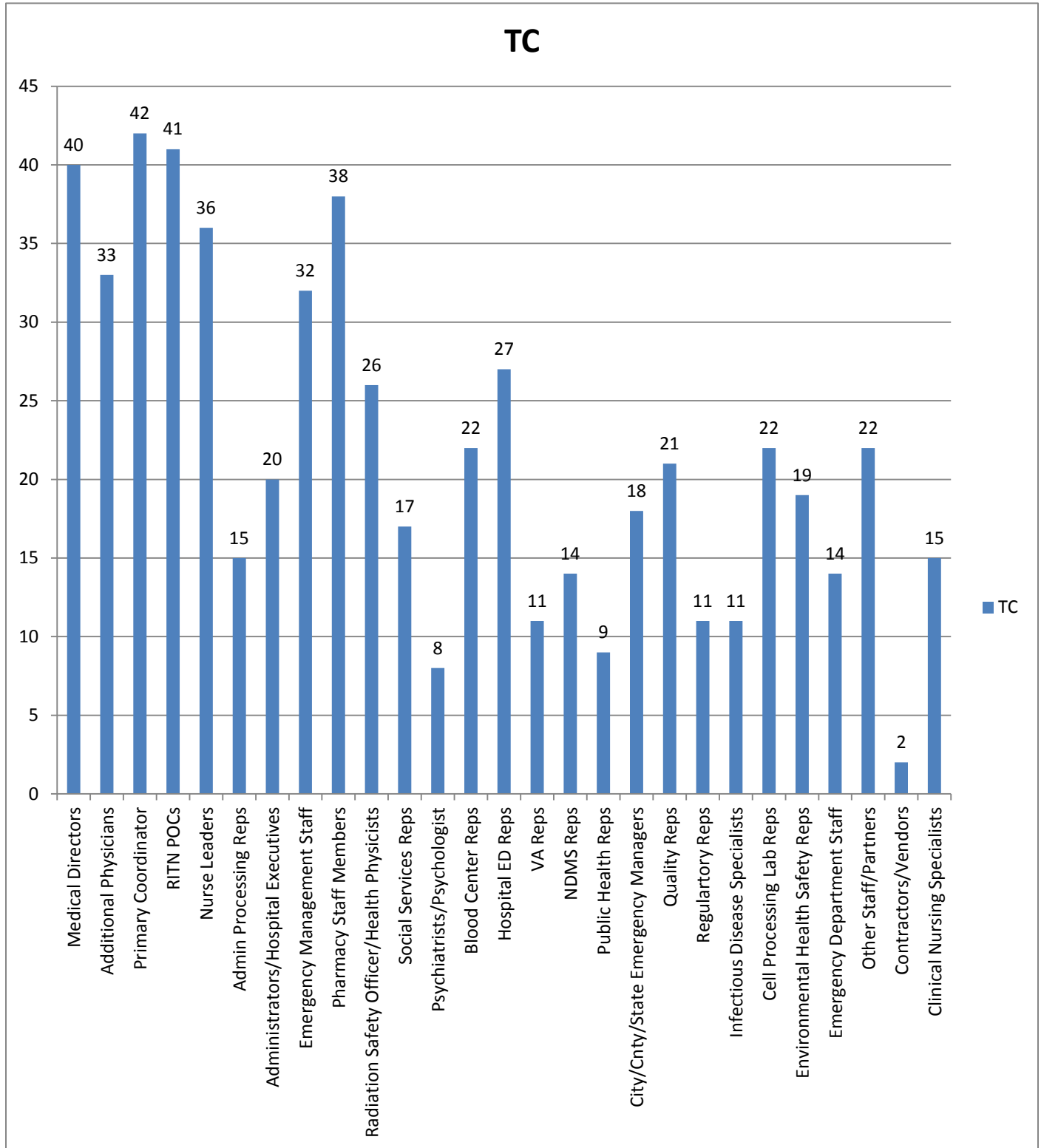
2011 RITN Tabletop Exercise Results (partial)

How many people participated in your exercise (keep a list of all who participated by name)?



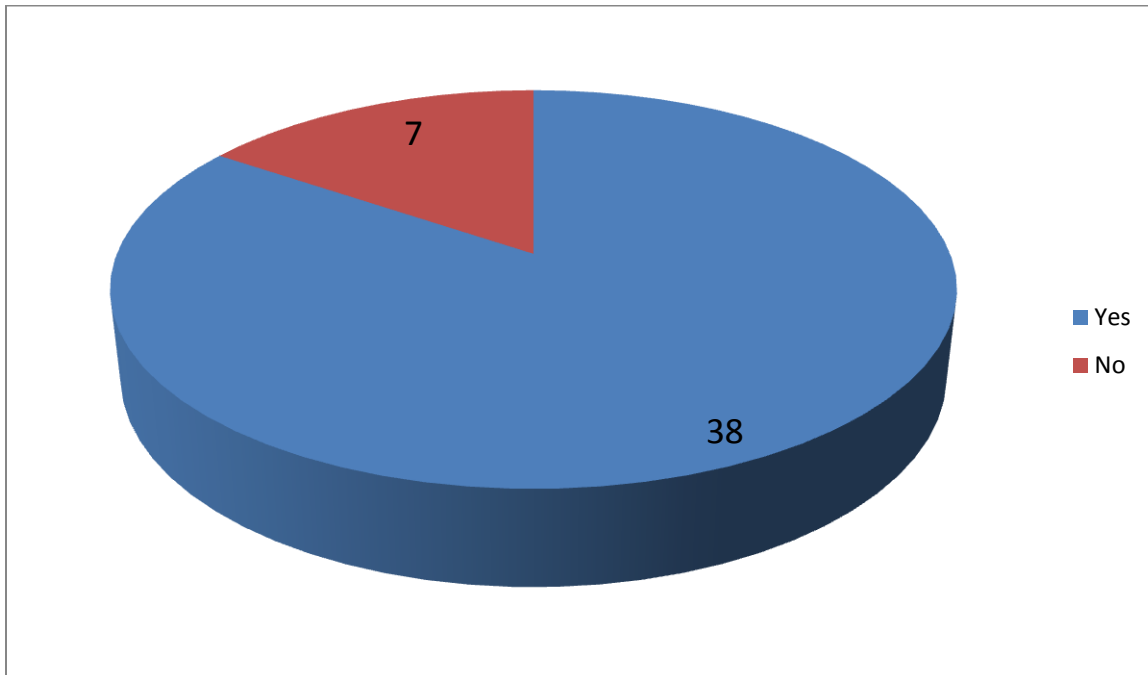

Identify all members of your incident response team (Select all that apply)

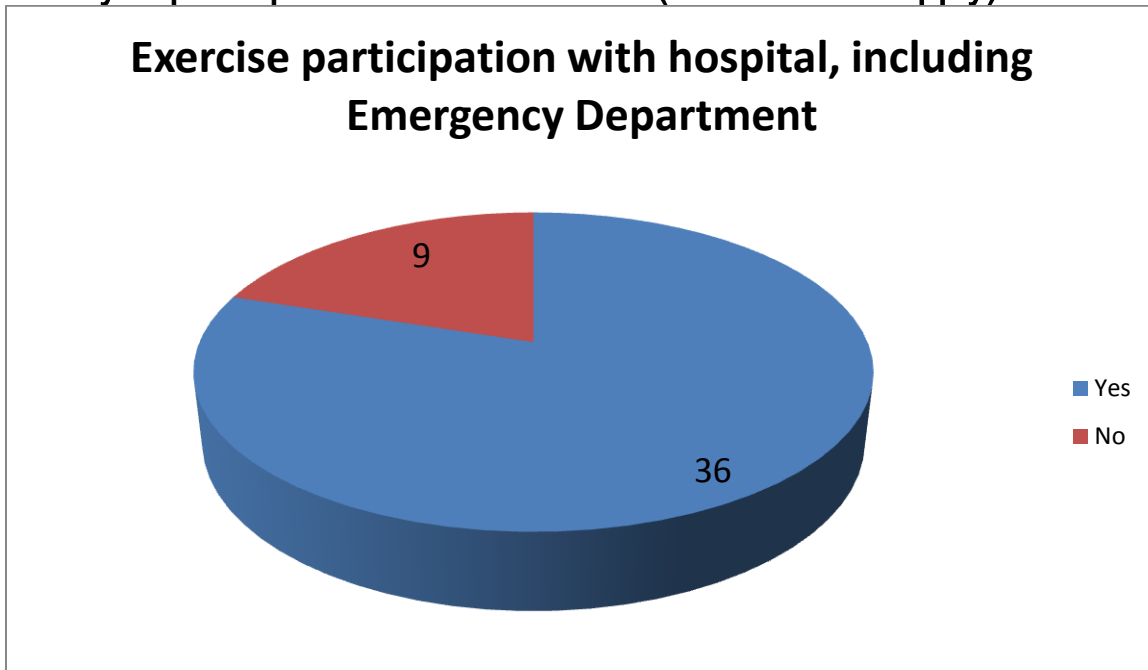

RITN centers will likely receive patients through NDMS for specialized care. Is your hospital contracted with the National Disaster Medical System?

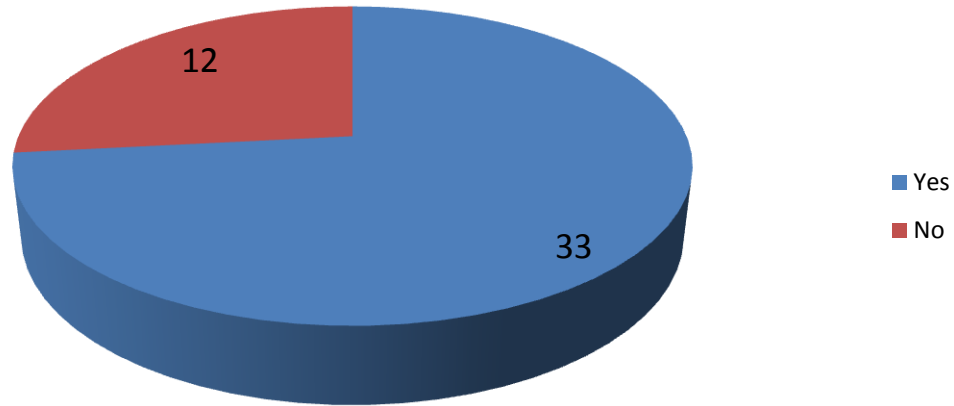

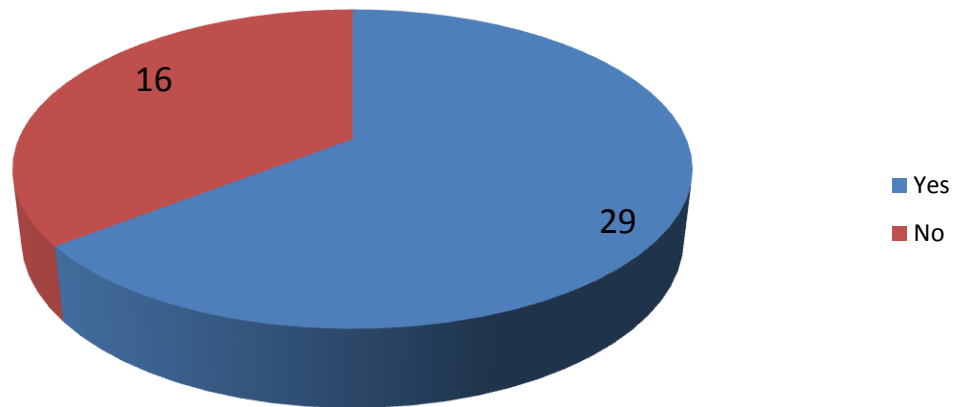

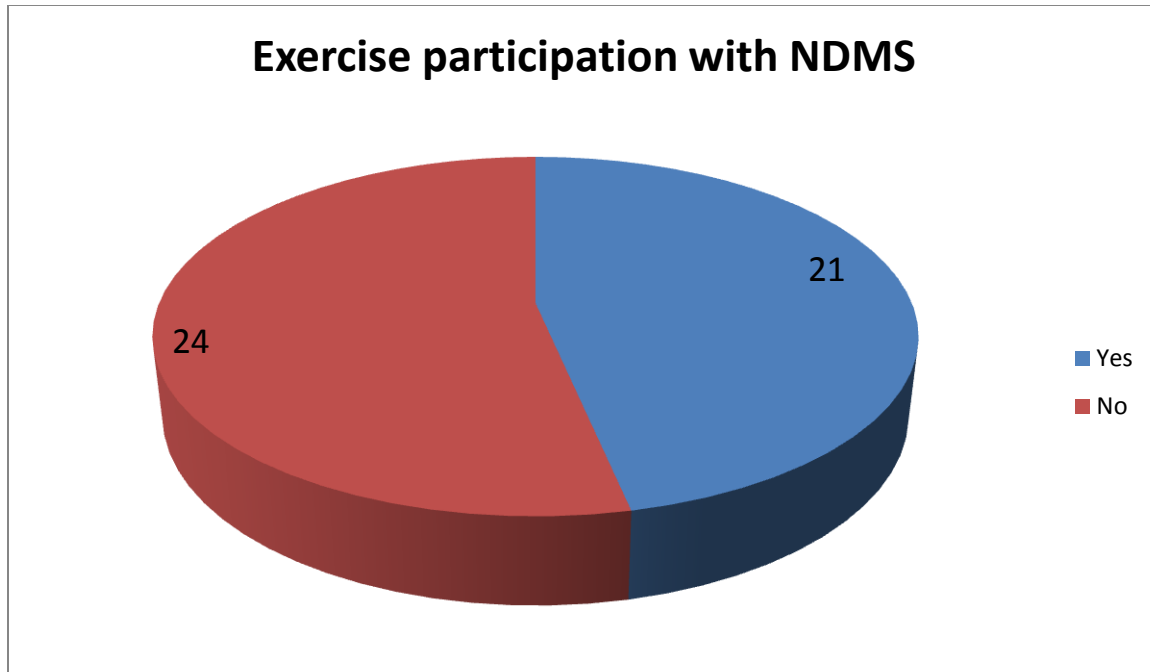

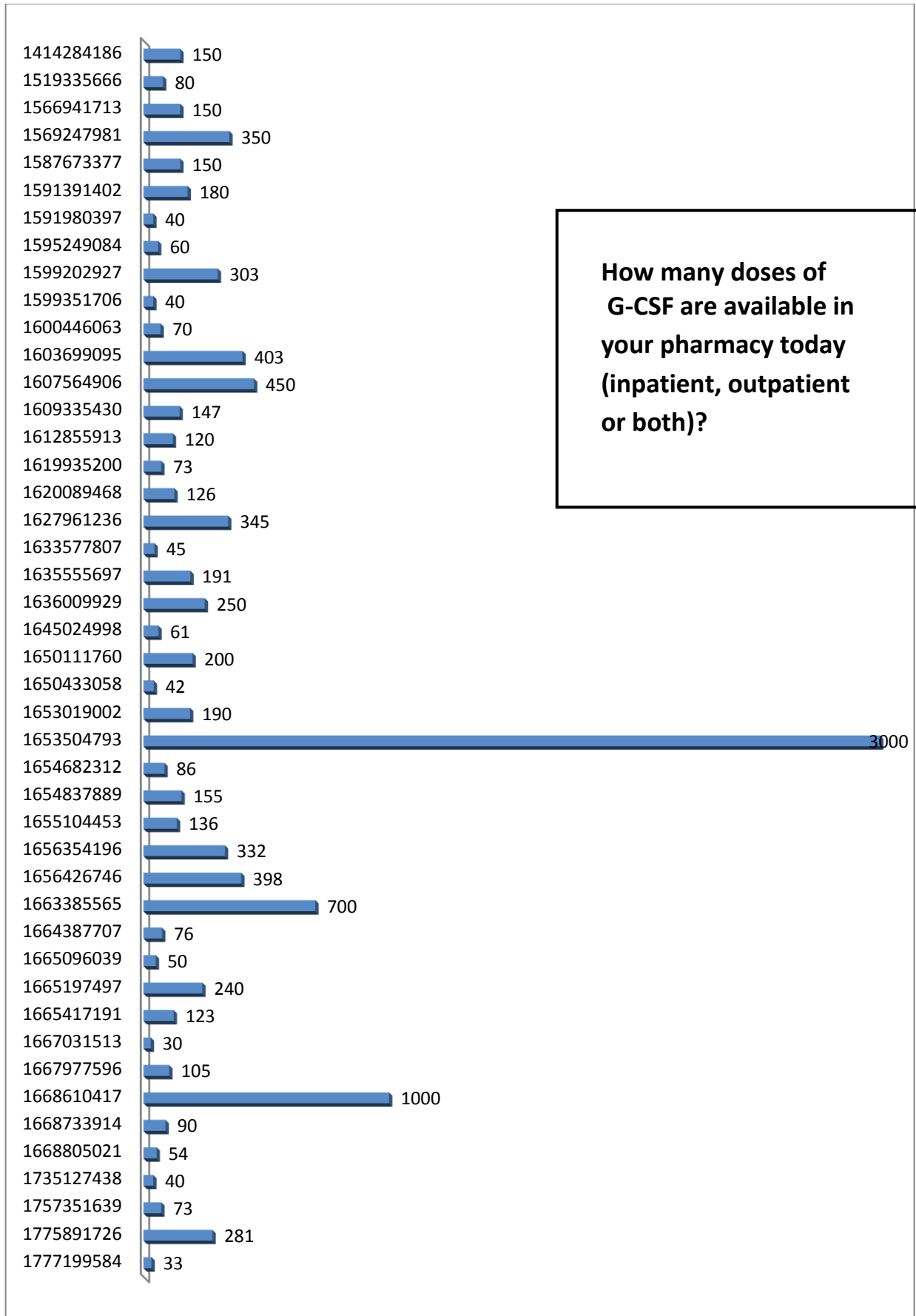
